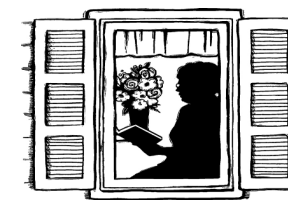

The Covenant

Scripture Reading: I Samuel 1:24-28

Pastor: As Hannah brought Samuel to the Lord, these parents Paul and Hope, and their child Landon come today in like manner. According to Jesus, the greatest commandment is, *“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might.”* God instructed that this commandment *shall be on your heart and you should teach them diligently to your children.* Realizing that children learn best by the life we live before them, it is important that our lives be totally committed to God.
